

Restricted Driver Authorisation Notification

Transport Operations (Passenger Transport) Regulation 2018

Restricted Driver Authorisation (RDA)

RDA is a type of driver authorisation that may be issued to a driver by an accredited operator of a community or courtesy transport service. Holders of RDA are authorised to drive a vehicle providing a community or courtesy transport service for the operator who issued the RDA. A person may hold more than one RDA.

This form enables an accredited operator of a community or courtesy transport service to assess the suitability of a person before issuing them with RDA. The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) also conducts checks to assess the suitability of a person to hold RDA.

Before completing this form:

- · drivers should read information bulletins:
 - PT305 Restricted Driver Authorisation for Drivers
 - PT307 Driver Responsibilities.
- · operators should read information bulletin:
 - PT206 Operators issuing Restricted Driver Authorisation.

Information bulletins are available on TMR's website www.tmr.qld.gov.au/information_bulletins.

To be issued RDA, a person must:

- have a satisfactory criminal and driving history
- hold a current open or restricted driver licence (Australian or overseas)
- · have held for at least three years in total an open, restricted, provisional or probationary driver licence (Australian or overseas)
- · be medically fit.

If an applicant declares any criminal or driving history, the operator must submit the application to TMR for assessment before RDA can be issued.

Conditions of RDA

- RDA can only be issued by an accredited operator of a community transport service or courtesy transport service.
- Holders of RDA are only authorised to drive a vehicle being used to provide a community transport service or courtesy transport service for the operator who issued the RDA.
- RDA can be issued up to a maximum of 12 months.
- RDA cannot be renewed. However, an operator may issue a new RDA by completing a new application before the RDA is due to expire.
- Within three working days of issuing RDA, the operator must email/fax/post the completed Restricted Driver Authorisation
 Notification form and any associated documents to their nearest TMR TransLink regional passenger transport office. For contact details refer to www.translink.com.au/contact-us.
- The RDA issued by the operator must be carried by the driver when the driver is providing a community or courtesy transport service for the operator. The RDA should be issued on the operator's letterhead and must contain certain information. Refer to the Restricted Driver Authorisation Pro-Forma - Employers Letter (form F3881 on TMR's website www.tmr.qld.gov.au) as an example to ensure all necessary information is captured on the RDA.
- RDA is automatically cancelled when the person stops being engaged by the operator to provide the service for which the RDA
 was granted.
