Conditional Vehicle Registration Duty Exemptions

1. Registered operator is a licensed motor dealer

Where the motor vehicle has been acquired by a licensed motor dealer for sale in the course of and for the purpose of carrying on the business of such licensee. The dealer must maintain records as prescribed by the *Duties Act 2001* Chapter 9.

DEAL

2. Licensed motor dealer - demonstration vehicle

Applicant is a motor dealer and the application is for the registration of a 'demonstration' model not previously registered.

DEAL

3. Previous interstate registration

Where the vehicle was registered and duty paid in another state, and the application is made by the same registered operator/s or a relative of the registered operator/s. 'Relative' is spouse, parent, child, grandparent, grandchild or one of their spouses.

NAME

4. Previous Qld registration

Where the applicant is the same person in whose name the vehicle was registered previously in Qld.

NAME

5. Repossession

An owner who has repossessed the motor vehicle pursuant to a hire purchase agreement or by an owner to whom the motor vehicle has been returned by the hirer voluntarily under a hire purchase agreement or on the termination of a hiring agreement.

REPO

6. Redemption

A hirer who has redeemed the motor vehicle that was previously repossessed. This applies only when the registration of the vehicle is to be recorded in the same name as before repossession. This category also applies to a private repossession.

REDE

7. Same business name/owner

Where the applicant is the sole owner/s of the business or another business owned solely by the same owner/s, as the previous registration.

NAME

8. New registered operator is Local Government operated

A local government, a regional health authority established under the *Health Services Act 1991*, the Qld Ambulance Service or the Qld Fire and Rescue Authority.

9. New registered operator is Government operated

The Crown or any corporation representing the Crown or any Department, sub-Department, Board or Commission under the State Government.

10. New registered operator is an ex-serviceperson

An ex-serviceperson who acquires the vehicle, not used for commercial purposes and receives a concession on registration fees due to an injury resulting from war service. Registration must be recorded in the sole name of the ex-serviceperson. The acquirer may need to provide a letter from the Department of Veterans' Affairs stating their disability.

EXSV

11. New registered operator is a person who has lost the use of one or both legs

A person who has lost the use of one or both legs and who uses the vehicle for transport to and from his/her place of employment or place of education because he/she is unable to use public transport due to the disability. The education must be for the purpose of obtaining employment. A declaration to that effect is required from the applicant. A letter from a medical practitioner to that effect is also required.

DISA

12. Transfer duty (i.e. contract/sale duty) paid on another document

An applicant who is required to pay conveyance duty to the Commissioner of Stamp Revenue on any other instrument (*e.g. contract for sale of a business or a farm*) relating to the transaction by which the vehicle was acquired, including duty on the value of the vehicle. However, unless the applicant has previously obtained from the Office of State Revenue an endorsement on this form that such conveyance duty has been paid, they must pay the duty when they submit their Conditional Vehicle Registration Application and later claim a refund from the Office of State Revenue.

13. Other reason for exemption

Duty Recovery - The Commissioner of State Revenue may take action against the registered operator/s when recovering outstanding duty on a Conditional Vehicle Registration Application.

Conditional Vehicle Registration Duty

Conditional vehicle registration duty is \$25.00 per application.

Gas Certificate Exemptions

You must present the relevant Gas Certificate unless exempt. The issue date of the Certificate must not be more than 3 months before the application for registration.

Exemptions for gas fuel systems only

1. A new vehicle, never registered anywhere and fitted with a Gas Compliance Plate.
2. Registering an unregistered vehicle in the same name that it was previously registered.
3. Remote areas (contact Department of Transport and Main Roads Customer Service for localities).
4. A dealer demonstration vehicle.
5. The vehicle is garaged on a Qld island where there is no authorised gas examiner/installer on the island.

Registration Category

Limited access

Restricted to operating in a defined worksite or designated area (for example, resort or carpark). All conditionally registered vehicles can have this option.

CRLA

Zone access

Various levels of access to the road network, depending on area of operation. Distance restrictions of 20, 40, and 80kms apply depending on their areas of operation in Qld.

CRZA

Unrestricted access

Unlimited use of the road network. Restrictions concerning hours of operation, mass or dimensions apply.
