

Remove and/or Attach Personalised/Customised Number Plate/s Application



Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995 (TORUM)

- This form must be completed and signed by a registered operator of the vehicle that the plates are being attached to or removed from.
- If you are removing personalised plates and attaching them to a vehicle with a different registered operator, two forms must be completed (one to remove and one to attach).
- Personalised plates can be attached to a vehicle registered in different name/s to the plate owner/s.
- Customised plates can only be attached to a vehicle registered in exactly the same name/s as the plate owner/s.
- Evidence of Identity (EOI), such as a Queensland Driver Licence, must be provided at time of lodgement for one registered operator of the vehicle and all plate owners. Refer to the separate *Evidence of Identity Requirements for Individuals Information Sheet* (S5385) or *Evidence of Identity Requirements for Organisations Information Sheet* (S5386) or tmr.qld.gov.au for EOI requirements.
- If you are removing standard number plates to attach personalised/customised plates, the standard plates must be returned with this application.
- You cannot attach or remove plates if the vehicle is under a Queensland Police Number Plate Confiscation Notice.
