Photo Identification Card Act 2008; Transport Planning and Coordination Act 1994

- To apply for a Photo Identification (ID) card, you must be at least 15 years of age and reside in Queensland (Qld).
- You can lodge your completed application at a Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) customer service centre or, if you live in a rural area, a QGAP office, Magistrate Court or local police station that provides licensing services.
- Evidence of identity (EOI) such as a Qld Driver Licence, must be provided at time of lodgement. For more information, go to qld.gov.au/EvidenceOfldentity.

Privacy Statement: TMR collects this information under the Photo Identification Card Act and the Transport Planning and Coordination Act so you may apply for a Photo ID Card. TMR may disclose this information to the Queensland Police Service (QPS) and interstate agencies that issue proof of age or photo ID cards. Your digital photo may also be released to the QPS. TMR's card contractor will have controlled access to your information, digitised signature and digital photo to make your card. Information, including your digital photo or digitised signature, may be disclosed to an authorised agency if the information is connected to an application for its product. Your information will not be disclosed to any other third party without your consent, unless authorised or required by law.
