

Certificate of Exemption for Late Night Driving Application

Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995

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This form is to be used if you are required to comply with a late night driving restriction for one year but you need to drive between 11pm and 5am and you wish to apply for a certificate of exemption to allow you to drive between these hours.

Confirmation of your late night driving restriction

You should have received a notice from the Department of Transport and Main Roads advising you of your late night driving restriction and the dates you are required to comply. This notice was issued to you after:

- a. you agreed to a one year good driving behaviour period
- the suspension of your driver licence (imposed because of a speeding offence or the accumulation of demerit points) had ended
- c. your court imposed licence disqualification period had ended. You may be eligible to apply for a certificate of exemption if you meet the following requirements:
- 1. You are able to prove that you have a need to drive between 11pm and 5am:
 - a. to or from your place of employment
 - b. as part of your employment.
- You are able to prove that a refusal to grant the certificate
 of exemption would cause severe hardship, to yourself
 or your family because you have taken on a role of special
 responsibility in relation to your family. For example, your
 family relies on you for financial support.

Additional information

The lodgement of this application does not guarantee it will be approved. Your traffic history will be considered. Once received, your application will be assessed and you will be advised of the outcome within 28 days.

The application may be lodged together with the application fee (cheque or money order payable to the Department of Transport and Main Roads) by mail to—

You may also lodge the application and pay the application fee (cash, EFTPOS or major credit cards - a credit card surcharge will apply) at your nearest Department of Transport and Main Roads customer service centre or Queensland Government licence issuing centre. The Department of Transport and Main Roads will not disclose your personal information to any other third parties without your consent unless authorised or required by law.
