



High-Powered Vehicle Restriction Exemption Application (Business)

Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995 (TORUM)

Use this form if you are a business applying for an exemption to allow your employees who are young drivers subject to a High-Powered Vehicle (HPV) restriction to drive high-powered vehicles.

For vehicles manufactured on or after 1 January 2010 a HPV is a car that has:

- a power-to-weight ratio of more than 130kW/tonne
- an engine that has been modified or replaced in accordance with modification codes LA1, LA2, LA3 or LA4 of the Queensland Road Vehicle Modification Handbook. Further information can be found on the *Certificate of Exemption for Driving High-Powered Vehicle Information Sheet* (form S4478).

For vehicles manufactured before 1 January 2010 a HPV is a car that has:

- eight or more cylinders
- a supercharged or turbocharged engine, not diesel powered
- an engine that has a power output of more than 210kW under the manufacturer's specifications for the car
- a rotary engine that has an engine capacity of more than 1146cc under the manufacturer's specifications for the car
- an engine modification requiring approval under section 17 of the VSS Regulation.

Eligibility Criteria

You may be eligible for a business certificate of exemption from the HPV restriction if you can demonstrate that:

- driving HPVs is necessary to the operation of your business, for example, your business provides a service that directly relates to HPVs
- your employees are required to drive HPVs as part of their normal duties
- driving HPVs is an essential component of your employee's tasks and the tasks cannot be undertaken in a vehicle that is not a HPV.

You may lodge the application and pay the application fee by cheque or money order made payable to the Department of Transport and Main Roads by mail to:
