Tow truck operator accreditation holders must use this form to provide evidence that they have a contract with a private property owner or occupier to tow vehicles from their premises on their behalf. A copy of this form must be carried by the tow truck driver and shown to a motorist or authorised person if requested to do so. The original copy must be kept in safe custody at the tow truck operator accreditation holder's business address.
