- Evidence that you are the organisation's representative. Acceptable evidence includes an authorisation on the organisation's letterhead or a completed *Authority to represent Registered Operator Vehicle Registration* (form F5225)
- Evidence of your identity. You may provide your Queensland (Qld) driver licence, Industry Authority, Marine Licence Indicator (conditions apply), Adult Proof of Age (APA) Card or Photo Identification (Photo ID) Card. If you do not hold a Qld Smartcard, you are required to show either one Category A document or one Category B document (with name and signature).
