

Alcohol Ignition Interlock Program -Interlock Exemption Application

Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995 (TORUM)

This form is to be used if you are required to participate in the Alcohol Ignition Interlock Program and are applying for an exemption from participating.

You may be eligible to apply for an interlock exemption for any of the following reasons:

- · You have a medical condition
- You live in a remote location
- You live on an island
- You or your family member will experience severe hardship if you are not granted an exemption.

Note: An interlock exemption cannot be granted if you are unable to install the interlock for employment, education or financial reasons.

Exemption eligibility criteria are listed in section four.

Additional information

Applications can be lodged up to six weeks prior to your disqualification end date or at any time during your interlock period.

You can lodge your completed form and pay the application fee at a Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) customer service centre or, if you live in a rural area, a Queensland Government Agency Program office or your local police station that provides licensing services. If you live on any of the following islands you are not eligible for an exemption under this criteria: Coochiemudlo Island, Fraser Island, Karragarra Island, Lamb Island, Macleay Island, Magnetic Island, North Stradbroke Island, Orpheus Island, Russell Island.  Exemption Criteria 4 – Severe hardship A I only have one vehicle reasonably available to me and my *family member, and: it is not physically possible to fit an interlock (as advised by both of the interlock providers) to the vehicle and myself or my *family member will experience severe hardship if my application is not approved and no other transport is reasonably available to myself or my family member. An interlock exemption cannot be granted if you are unable to install the interlock for employment, educational or financial reasons. Provide the 'Documents required' then Go to 5 to provide additional details. 	 Letters from all interlock providers explaining that an interlock cannot be physically fitted into your vehicle, and: Evidence to support all of the following: only one vehicle is reasonably available not being granted an interlock exemption would cause you or your family member severe hardship no other transport is reasonably available to you or your family member.

Exemption Criteria 4 – Severe hardship D	Evidence to support both of the following:
My *family member has no other transport reasonably available, and:	 not being granted an exemption would cause you or your family member severe hardship

 the severe hardship that the family member will experience is not related to me being unable to drive them for employment or education reasons.

It is an offence under the TORUM to state anything or provide a document to a departmental officer if you know it contains false or misleading information. The maximum penalty may exceed \$8000.

Privacy Statement: TMR provides this form under the TORUM so that you may apply for an exemption from the Alcohol Ignition Interlock Program requirement that only allows you to drive a nominated vehicle that has been fitted with an approved interlock. The information collected on this form is accessible by authorised departmental persons and some of this information may be disclosed to the Queensland Police Service and interstate driver licensing authorities. TMR will not disclose your personal details to any other third parties without your consent unless authorised or required by law.
