



- This inspection can be carried out by a Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) officer for all motorhomes or a Queensland Police Service Officer or a HVRAS Authorised Person for motorhomes over 4.5 tonne only.
- This inspection sheet must be used in conjunction with *Vehicle Details Inspection Sheet (form F3529)* or *Change of Vehicle Particulars (form F3524)*.
- A HVRAS Authorised Person cannot inspect an imported motorhome/campervan prior to first registration in Australia.
- This inspection is for a motorhome/campervan with GVM over 4.5 tonne only. For motorhomes/campervans with a GVM of 4.5 tonne or less a modification certificate with code LH11 is required.
- Do not use this form for a motorhome with a designated load carrying space as it must be registered as a truck or bus.

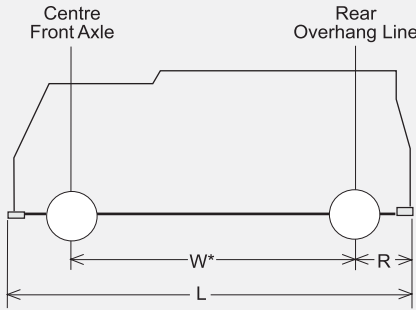

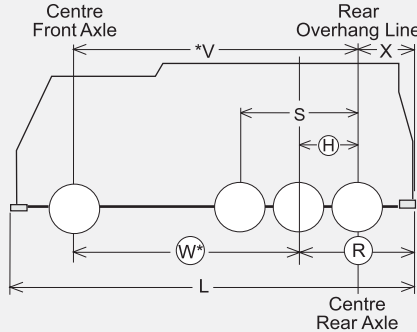
4. Measurements

- Vehicles to be measured are all vehicles over 4.5 tonne GVM.
- Using the diagram as a guide, provide the following dimensions in metres correct to two decimal places (e.g. 12.54, 2.42).
- Write the number of tyres per axle in the wheel spaces.
- Letters in circles, for example (R), indicate distances that are able to be calculated using formulas provided.
- If the motorhome/campervan is fitted with a retractable axle, all measurements are to be taken with the retractable axle in contact with the ground and in the lifted position. Use a separate inspection sheet for each configuration.

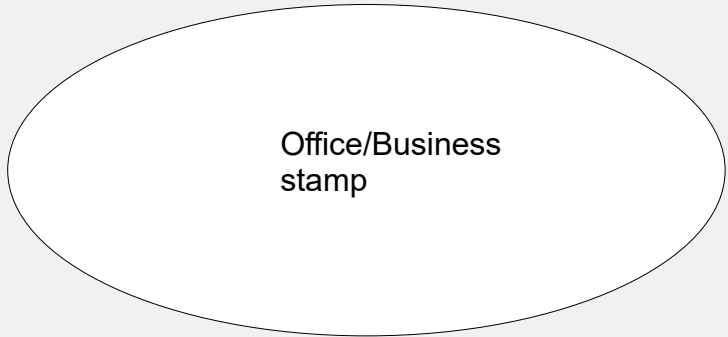
