Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995 (TORUM)



- This form is used when you:
 - apply to retain a standard number plate combination:
 - currently on your vehicle (including ordering a slimline plate). **Note:** only registered operators can apply or
 - that was issued in the past and is not currently on a vehicle. Call 13 23 80 to confirm plate number is available.
- Once new plates are received, old plates must be surrendered.
- You cannot customise plates if the vehicle is under a Queensland Police Number Plate Confiscation Notice.
