



Cancel Personalised/Customised Number Plate Application

Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995



- This form must be completed and signed by all plate owners when cancelling personalised/customised number plates.
- Evidence of Identity (EOI), such as a Queensland Driver Licence, must be provided at the time of lodgement for all plate owners. Refer to the separate *Evidence of Identity Requirements for Individuals Information Sheet* (S5385) or *Evidence of Identity Requirements for Organisations Information Sheet* (S5386) or tmr.qld.gov.au for EOI requirements.
- You cannot apply to cancel personalised/customised number plates if the vehicle the plates are attached to is currently under a Queensland Police Number Plate Confiscation Notice.
- No refund is available for cancelled personalised/customised plates.
- The personalised/customised plates must be surrendered at the time this application is made unless the plates are lost, stolen or destroyed.
