



Seasonal registration allows an eligible heavy vehicle to be registered for three or six months and then have the registration term made dormant (put on hold) while it's not being used (such as outside of a harvest period). The vehicle's registration may be left as dormant for up to 12 months (or two years if the property is affected by drought or natural disaster) before the next seasonal registration term starts.

Criteria:

1. The vehicle must be a prime mover or truck with a gross vehicle mass of at least 6 tonnes or a trailer with a mass rating for charging of more than 4.5 tonnes.
2. The registered operator of the vehicle is a primary producer and the vehicle is only used for their business of primary production.
3. The registered operator of the vehicle is someone other than a primary producer and the vehicle is only used to transport primary produce from a farm or fishing waters to where the primary produce is one of the following:
 - loaded onto a train, vessel or other vehicle
 - stored before being processed
 - processed.

A primary producer is a person whose business consists mainly of the production of primary produce (raw material for clothing or food).

4. Change dormant seasonal registration

What change would you like to make to your dormant (on hold) seasonal registration?

Commence active seasonal registration:

- 3 months 6 months

Extend the dormant period for up to two years due to a drought or natural disaster.

Change the vehicle registration to a standard registration:

- 3 months 6 months 12 months

Cancel the vehicle's registration.
