Recreational Speed Boat

means a boat/personal water craft that is solely powered by a motor with all of the following:

- engine capacity greater than 4.5 kilowatts
- capable of travelling in excess of 10 knots
- planing or non-displacement hull.

Recreational Motor Boat

means a boat that falls into one of the following categories:

- engine capacity between 3.0 and 4.5 kilowatts
- capable of travelling at less than 10 knots.

Other Queensland Regulated Ship

means ships that:

- are less than 6 metres
- carry 12 persons or fewer
- operate within 15 nautical miles from land.

Prescribed Other Queensland Regulated Ship

means ships:

- that are 6 metres or more in length; or
- designed to carry more than 12 persons on the ship; or
- operate more than 15 nautical miles from land.
