As a buoy mooring applicant, you must:

- · abide by the conditions as outlined on the Authority
- attach the nominated vessel to the buoy mooring for at least 60% of the year (restricted moorings only)
- have the same name/s on this application form as your vessel registration (if applicable)
- provide evidence of your identity by providing one of the following documents (that is, Queensland Driver Licence, Adult Proof of Age or Photo Identification card, Industry Authority or Marine Licence Indicator card). For a full list of acceptable evidence of identity (EOI) documents, go to www.qld.gov.au/EvidenceOfldentity
- provide an emergency contact who is a person who can tend to the vessel in an emergency if you are unable to.

Additionally, you must not:

- leave the mooring unattended for more than 90 continuous days without notifying the relevant Maritime Safety Queensland regional office/Gold Coast Waterways Authority office
- provide the buoy moorings to a third party (restricted moorings only)
- sell or transfer the buoy mooring authorities.
