1. No access


 The course is not available in person in the area you live

 You or a family member will experience severe hardship if you are required to complete the course.



How to lodge your application

- · Complete the application form
- Lodge your application (with your evidence) and pay the fee

Applications can be lodged after your driver licence disqualification ends and at any time during your interlock period. To view the current repeat drink driving course exemption application fee, go to qld.gov.au/DriverFees
