

Attach One Number Plate to a Specific Conditionally Registered Vehicle Application

Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995 (TORUM)

- This form must be completed if you are applying to attach one number plate to the rear of a specific conditionally registered vehicle registered under limited access registration.
- Eligible vehicles include golf buggies, and other conditionally registered vehicles registered under limited access registration, constructed in a way that means a front number plate could be easily damaged or lost and cannot be placed on the vehicle in a suitable alternative position.
- A copy of Evidence of Identity (EOI) for one registered operator must be provided at time of lodgement. For example, for an individual a Queensland Driver Licence. Organisational EOI is only required if TMR cannot verify the status of the organisation as 'registered' with ASIC. Refer to the separate *Evidence of Identity Information Sheet (F4362)* or qld.gov.au/evidenceofidentity for EOI requirements.
- A copy of authorisation letter from the land/area owner or authority responsible for the management of the road must be provided, as well as a copy of the permit from the QPS (if applicable).
- Completed applications can be lodged by email at lavr@tmr.qld.gov.au, by post to the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR), Registration Policy Unit, PO Box 673, FORTITUDE VALLEY QLD 4006, or in person at a TMR customer service centre.
- If you are applying for more than one vehicle, please provide the details in items 2 to 6 on a separate sheet.
