While no consent is required from the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) for the erection of a roadside memorial that meets these standards, TMR encourages the responsible person to provide all relevant details on this form. Should the memorial need to be relocated, modified or removed TMR can easily locate the responsible person and obtain their assistance with the required action.

General standards

- Small in size and securely fixed
- A white wooden cross (see page 2 for standards)
- Height 750mm
- Width 500mm
- Depth 400mm (below ground)
- Fresh flowers (no wrapping)
- No plastic flowers
- No heavy materials or large objects
- Not compromising safety of road users or visitors to the memorial site
- Not allowed within the clear zone (contact us for details)
- Not obstructing traffic controls or creating a distraction
- Not affixed to power poles, regulatory signs (traffic lights, stop signs) or in medians or roundabouts
- Not impeding TMR utility or emergency service maintenance operations
- Respect the amenity of local residents
- Not permitted for animals
- Consider your safety and the safety of visitors
- Not allowed on motorways, freeways and toll roads
- Consider alternatives, talk to TMR please.

Our commitment

TMR acknowledges that the death of a loved one as a result of a vehicle crash can be very traumatic. As such, TMR's approach to the location of roadside memorials will be sensitive to the emotions of affected community members.
