



Dangerous Goods Driver Licence Application

This form may be used by you to apply for:

- Dangerous Goods Driver Licence
- renewal of a Dangerous Goods Driver Licence.

To apply for a Dangerous Goods Driver Licence you must:

- produce your current Queensland (Qld) Open driver licence (or a current Qld Probationary or Restricted Driver Licence where you have previously held an Open Driver Licence)
- produce a Medical Certificate for Motor Vehicle Driver (form F3712) which has been assessed under commercial standards and completed within the last six months
- have current original/copy of the TLILIC 0001 Dangerous Goods Driver Course Certificate completed within the last six months
- pay the appropriate fee.

Additional information:

This application and fees must be lodged in person at a Department of Transport and Main Roads Customer Service Centre or QGAP Office.

Upon approval of your application, you can use an Interim Industry Authority as evidence that you are authorised to perform the role until your industry authority card arrives in the mail. To obtain your interim industry authority by email ask to sign up for TMR's e-reminders when submitting your application. For more information on e-reminders please refer to www.qld.gov.au/transport/enotice.

Renewal applications should be lodged no sooner than two weeks before the current expiry date. If you have an existing industry authority card, you must bring this with you.

Fees are not refundable if the application is unsuccessful.

Evidence of Identity (EOI) requirements

Refer to the EOI Requirements (form F4362) or the Department of Transport and Main Roads website www.tmr.qld.gov.au for a full list of EOI, evidence of Qld residential address and change of name documents.

Digital photo

You may be required to allow the taking of a digital photo to confirm your connection to the most recent digital photo kept by the Department of Transport and Main Roads or to renew the latest digital photo.

As part of the process you will need to provide the doctor with a completed Private and Commercial Vehicle Driver's Health Assessment (form F3195).

11 - Applicant's Declaration

I consent to TMR verifying my EOI information and using my personal information, digital photo and digitised signature for the purposes associated with my application for a Dangerous Goods Driver Licence.

I declare that I have read the above statement and that the answers given by me are complete, true and correct in every detail.

I understand that any false, misleading or incorrect information provided by me may result in the immediate cancellation of the Dangerous Goods Driver Licence.

Consent to conduct enquiries

I give my consent for TMR to conduct enquiries it deems necessary to assess my application and ongoing suitability to hold a Dangerous Goods Driver Licence. Including, but not necessarily limited to:

- a driving history check in all states and territories of Australia
- a national criminal history check (charges including those yet to be determined, convictions and certain investigative and disciplinary information) through the Queensland Police Service. I authorise the release of information by the Queensland Police Service and the Australian Police Service to TMR.
- further enquiries with the courts, police, prosecuting authorities or other such relevant bodies or entities necessary to enable TMR to make a full and informed assessment of my suitability for a Dangerous Goods Driver Licence.

I authorise TMR to use this information to maintain a database which is used to prepare correspondence, monitor transactions and to provide other government agencies with information relating to my Dangerous Goods Driver Licence.

I consent to TMR taking, keeping and using my personal information for the issue of a Dangerous Goods Driver Licence under the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act* or otherwise authorised by law.

Responsibilities as a Dangerous Goods Driver

I understand my responsibilities as the holder of a Dangerous Goods Driver Licence under the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act*.

I understand that failure to comply with all the relevant legislation and conditions may result in the suspension or cancellation of my Dangerous Goods Driver Licence.
