Before you apply

• Contact a course provider for your options

The course is free and widely available in person.
The course is also available online for people who cannot attend in person.

• Check if you are eligible to apply

You can only apply for an exemption for one of the following reasons:

1. No access

- The course is not available in person in the area you live

and

- you cannot complete the course online (via remote learning).

2. Severe hardship

- You or a family member will experience severe hardship if you are required to complete the course.



You must provide evidence to support the reason for your application

How to lodge your application

- Complete the application form
- Lodge your application (with your evidence) and pay the fee.

Applications can be lodged after your driver licence disqualification ends and at any time during your interlock period. To view the current repeat drink driving course exemption application fee, go to qld.gov.au/DriverFees

Evidence

You must provide a copy of one of the following documents showing your current residential address:

- Lease or rental agreement
- Electricity, gas or telephone bill
- Rates notice
- Land tax valuation notice
- Australian Tax Office notice
- Australian Electoral Enrolment letter
- Services Australia (Centrelink, Medicare or Child support) letter
- Mortgage or land ownership certificate.

We will check how far you live from the course provider and your internet coverage.

Section 3 - Severe hardship

There are reasons that cannot be considered as causing severe hardship

You **cannot apply** for any of these reasons:

- parenting or general care responsibilities
- employment
- education (or another place you usually go)
- family member's employment, education or another place they usually go
- no transport available to attend in person
- cannot afford travel costs to attend in person
- cannot afford internet charges to attend online via remote learning.

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
